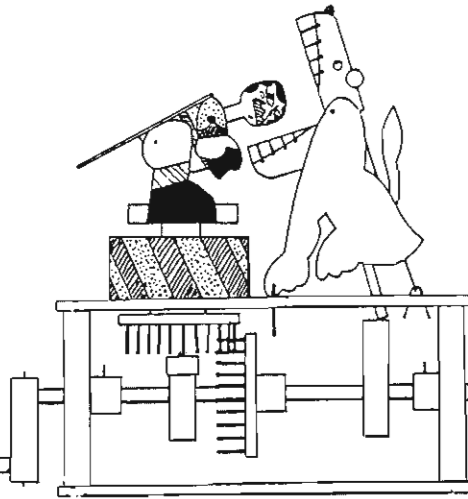

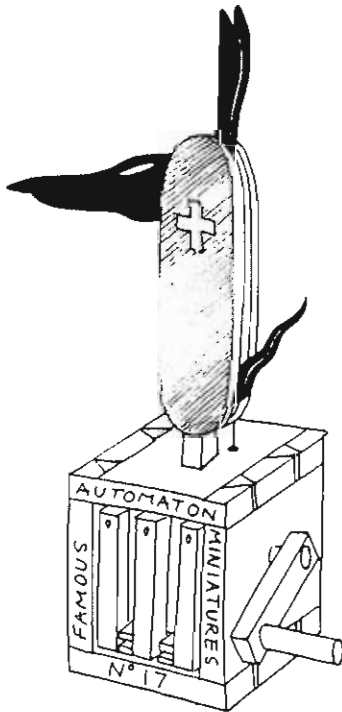
The 14 Balls team of Paul Spooner and Matthew Smith have revived the Swiss Army Knife (PS made 6 a

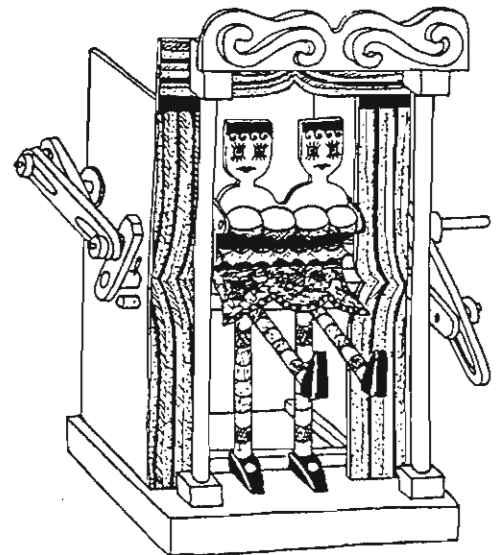

Singer - Another Markey design, this time the lady stands behind a microphone and sways from side to side. £32-50.

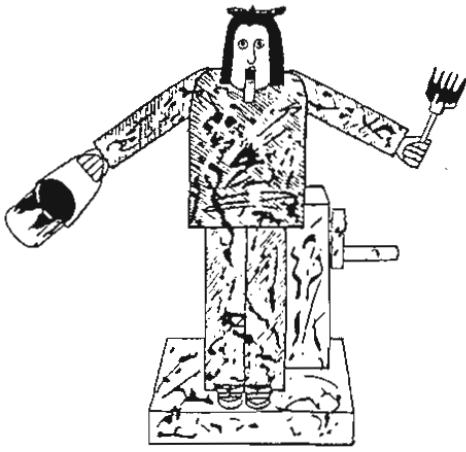

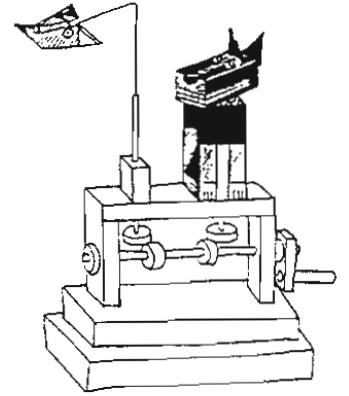

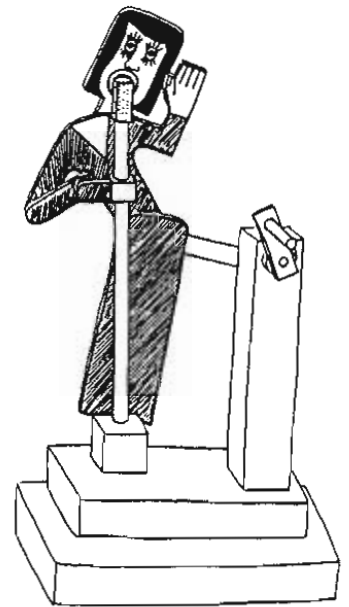
Ordering Information
