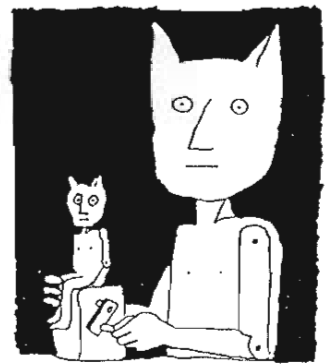

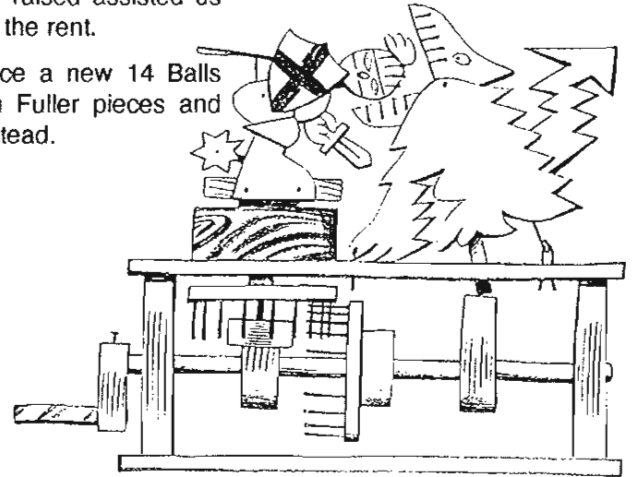
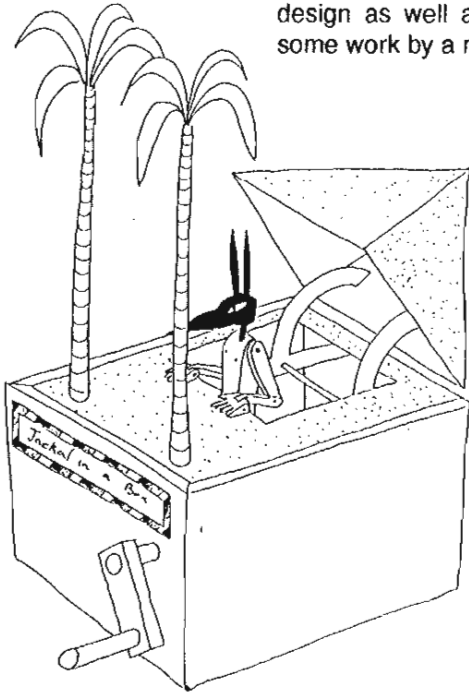

This time we are pleased to announce a new 14 Balls design as well as some original Ron Fuller pieces and some work by a new artist, Keith Newstead.

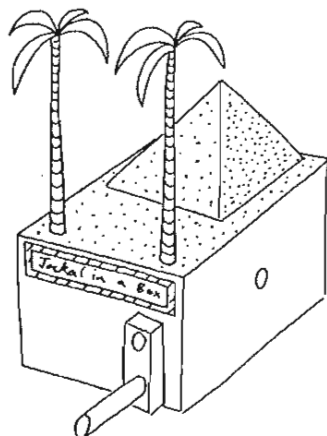


Ron Fuller

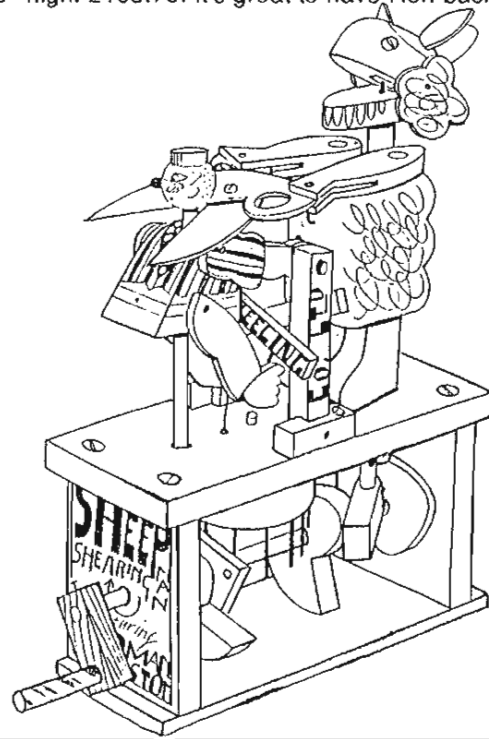

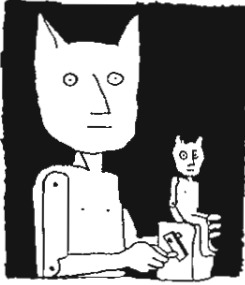
Jackal in a Box

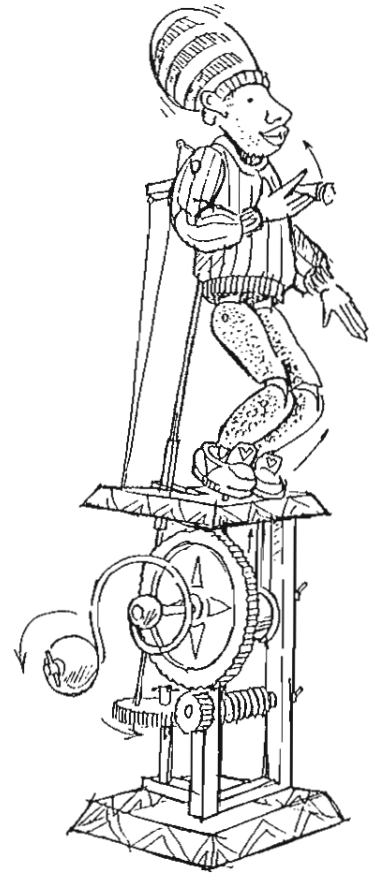

His automata are made from brass, wood and resin and are proving to be very popular in the shop. The Rastafarian is the first in a series caricaturing lesser known British eccentrics. Being only 8" high, the police don't even notice this laid-back figure as he walks and smokes with unique confidence. £117-50

We have one of Keith's exquisite Dragons on permanent display. They are handmade (what else?) from brass with a resin base. The wings flap and the legs kick, the tail twists and the mouth opens and closes. We are not wild about the idea of sending these through the post. £352-50.
